- ❖ GPA of 3.0 or better
- ❖ Completion of the *Application to the Education Program* form
- ❖ Three recommendations from faculty, one from Education and two from core studies
- ❖ An acceptable written autobiography
- ❖ Signed *Disposition Commitment* form
- ❖ An acceptable interview with advisor
- ❖ Completion of *Declaration of Major* form
