# The Office of Student Financial Services

## Where's My Tuition Bill?

- Bills are generated electronically (eBill)
- Iona College does not mail paper bills
- Each time an eBill is generated an email is sent automatically
- To access the eBill students must log in to their **myiona.iona.edu** account & select PeopleSoft
- Once logged in students can view or print their eBill, make payment or add an **Authorized User**

## Authorized Users

Students can authorize a parent or 3<sup>rd</sup> party to view and print bills and make payments to their student account and enroll in a payment plan.

Once you are set up as an Authorized User you will be notified via email every time a new eBill is generated. You can also opt-in to receive text message notifications (*Personal Profile, Communications*).

## Federal Direct Loan Program

Obtaining your Student Loans is a 4 step process

1. File the FAFSA - [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)
2. Accept your Financial Aid Awards – [myiona.iona.edu](http://myiona.iona.edu) & select PeopleSoft, click on Self Service > Campus Finances > Accept Awards
3. Sign your Master Promissory Note – [www.studentloans.gov](http://www.studentloans.gov)
4. Complete your Entrance Counseling – [www.studentloans.gov](http://www.studentloans.gov)

## Federal Direct PLUS Loans

...Is a loan available through the Federal Direct Loan program for the parents of dependent students.

To apply for a Parent PLUS Loan please visit  
[www.studentloans.gov](http://www.studentloans.gov)

You must complete a PLUS Loan application and Master Promissory Note.

\*If approved you may borrow up to the student's cost of attendance minus any financial aid the student is receiving. If denied the student is eligible for an additional unsubsidized loan in the amount of \$4000

## Iona College Monthly Payment Plan

- Pay your student's fall balance in **5 monthly installments**
- Enroll before August 1 – Fall Bill Due Date
- Enrollment Fee: \$50.00
- Don't forget to re-enroll in December for the Spring Semester – Spring Bill Due January 1

- Spring Semester Bill is Due January 1<sup>st</sup>

## Financial Aid

- To be eligible for financial aid the FAFSA must be filed every year by April 15 – [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)
- The FAFSA is required to receive both federal and institutional funds
- Please remember to have the student Accept their Awards by logging in to their myiona.iona.edu account & selecting PeopleSoft. Click on Self Service > Campus Finances > Accept Awards
